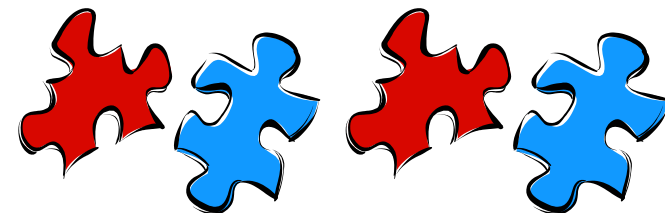
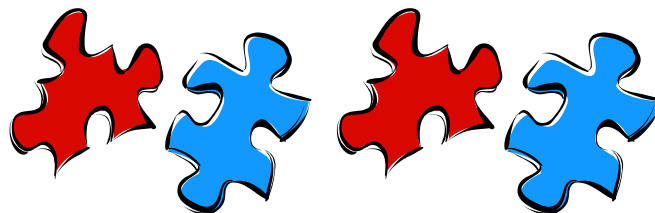
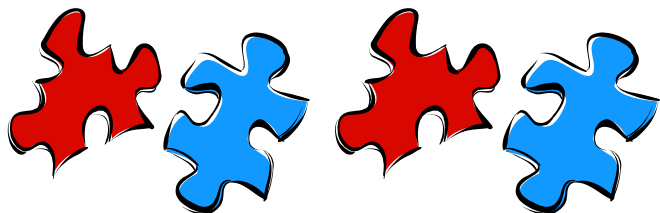
Reinforcement is also provided with activities of daily living, including but not limited to: assuming responsibility for self and others, practicing table manners, sharing and increasing knowledge of social skills, handling personal finances, and appropriately interacting with peers and adults. Every group will participate in different daily activities to best fit their abilities and needs.
